

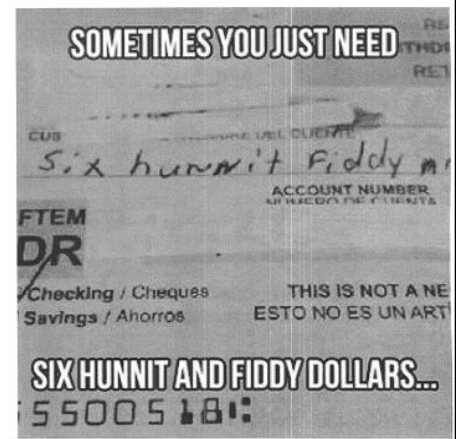
I used to be hell on wheels, Back when I was younger man,
