Here is a partial list: Barrett, AmmoClip, Extreme Firepower Inc, Cheaper Than Dirt, Midway USA, Dead Bang Guns, Delmarva Shooting Supply, King Armory MFG, West Desert, Tactical, Able Company Sports, Gadsden Guns Inc, III Arms Company, Badlands Arsenal, Ammodump International, Armtac, Lono Group, Big Sky Ammunition, Tier One Arms, Old Grouch's Military Surplus, Predator Intelligence, York Arms, Exile Machine, LaRue Tactical, Southwest Shooting Authority, Olympic Arms, Ammo2U, Shade's Landing Inc, Southern Appalachian Arms, Bullwater Enterprises, A & T Firearms, West Fork Armory, Iron Goat Guns, Trident Armory, Smith Enterprise Inc, Alex Arms, OFA Tactical, Snake Hound Machine, West Michigan Tactical, and the list is growing. 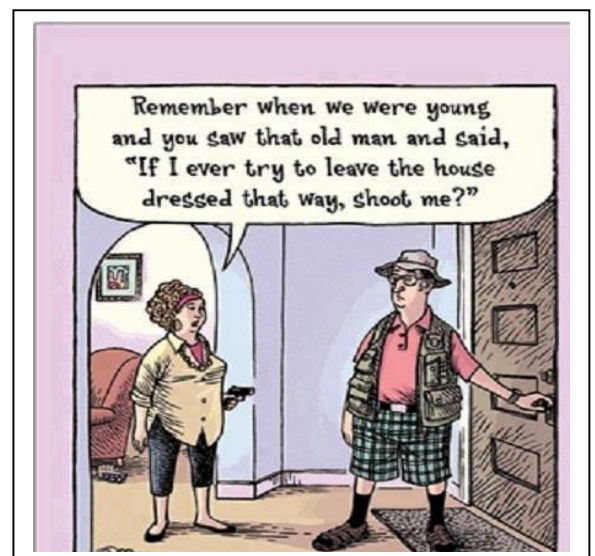
Red River Renegades shoots rifle/pistol the last Sunday and shotgun the second Sunday. Contact a club officer for directions.

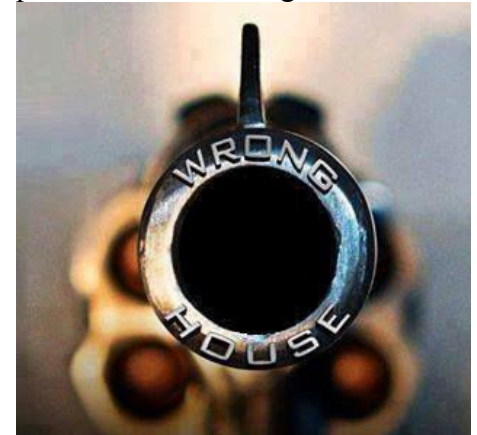
### Riddle me this, Batman
