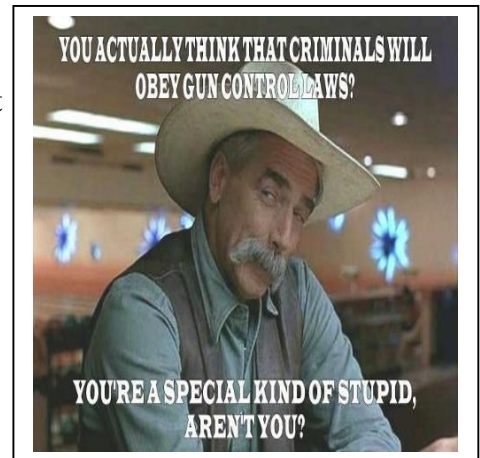
### **The Continuing Saga of Liver Eating Johnson**

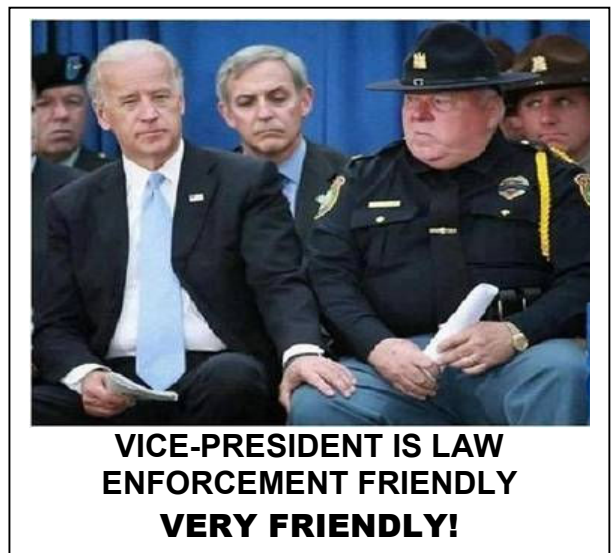

### **SO, CRIMINALS DON'T HAVE TO REGISTER THEIR GUNS??!!**

U.S. Supreme Court's 1968 Haynes v. U.S. decision: Haynes, a convicted felon, was convicted of unlawful possession of an unregistered short-barreled shotgun. He argued that for a convicted felon to register a gun was effectively an announcement to the government that he was breaking the law and that registration violated his Fifth Amendment protection against self-incrimination.

The court, by an 8 - 1 margin, agreed, concluding: "We hold that a proper claim of the constitutional privilege against self-incrimination provides a full defense to prosecutions either for failure to register a firearm, or for possession of an unregistered firearm."

So, when these gun registration schemes are announced, be very aware that only lawful gun-owners are required to register their firearms. Unlawful owners are exempted from registration laws due to their constitutional protection against self-incrimination.

### **TARGETS FOR THE MARCH SHOOT**

Posting the targets upside down really made things interesting this month. I know, I know, the wind and the cold did add an interesting factor. We don't need to get into a rut. The only difference between a rut and a grave is how deep. So to make up for the targets and the weather this month we will do something different again next month. All matches, all targets, all ranges, all guns will be shot from the bench. Bet you haven't done that in a while. Here are a few things to keep in mind. If your bench gun has a peep sight then it does not qualify to shoot in the percussion or flint match. Flint and percussion is to be shot with open metallic sights. Adjustable sights are OK. Also since we are shooting from a rest, pistol and revolver matches may be shot two handed. This is for the March shoot only. This is not an arbitrary change in club matches.
