We are probably looking at another warm Sunday for this month's shoot so let's all get up early and get to the range to beat the heat.

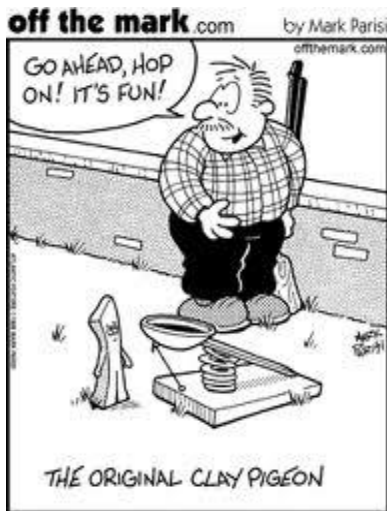
