HINTS FROM THE WORKSHOP * AKA THE HUSBAND'S LOAFING SHED

Creating that perfect powder horn can really add to one's vocabulary. It would just make just pirate blush. Making a screw tip is easier than trying to drill into a horn and not pop out the side. A ½ X 13 tap and die is a good choice. Use a piece of wire coat hanger to measure the inside of the horn. Saw off the tip about ½ inch shorter than the cavity. Drill into the horn and cut the female threads. File down the tip and cut the male threads. Drill the tip for the spout peg. How many times have you worked the tip down only to have the @#!*#@! thing split out when you put in the peg? Use a 1/4" flair nut from the plumbing section. File and fit until you can screw the on flair nut and let it cut threads as it goes. Add Epoxy for additional holding. To put in the plug you need to soften the horn by boiling. You might get by using the kitchen stove but don't use a kitchen pot unless you have a death wish (if you know what I mean). Shape the plug and insert while the horn is hot. Let cool and remove the hose clamp. Finish the horn to suit yourself.
